1st Day:

9:00 pm departure from Böblingen Panzerkaserne PX parking lot. 10:30 pm departure from Heidelberg PHV P&R parking lot (outside base, near new commissary), 10:30 pm departure from Kaiserslautern Daennerplatz (opposite Kleber Kaserne) P&R parking lot. 11:45 pm departure from Wiesbaden Hainerberg Military bus stop.

2nd Day:

Overnight travel to the Netherlands. Breakfast en route (not included). During a brief stop at a wooden shoe factory you can see how a piece of wood is transformed to Dutch footwear and then we share the delight of the city of AMSTERDAM with a sightseeing tour. There is time for a canal boat ride (not included), then we visit one of the many diamond factories for a diamond cutting demonstration and a chance to buy. In the afternoon you'll have free time to visit the Anne Frank House, discover the picturesque Red Light district or shop at the Flower



Market or join an excursion (€ 20 per person) to the Zuider lake. First we drive to the windmill park of Zaanse Schans. From there we continue on to the fishing village Volendam - a photographer's delight. In the evening we depart for the harbour of Hoek van Holland, near Rotterdam, where we board our ship. After check in you can enjoy buffet dinner on board (appr. € 21). Take advantage of the ship facilities afterwards. Overnight cruise to Great Britain.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

the Royal Palaces and Parks and to the famous Manneken Pis. We'll visit a lace shop where you can buy delectable hand made lace, and you'll have free time to taste the famous Belgian chocolates and beers. In the afternoon we depart for Germany. Dinner stop en route and late evening arrival at points of origin.

4th Day:

After buffet breakfast on board (included) we check out and drive to Belgium. Our city tour of BRUSSELS will take us to the Atomium, to
